

Annual Flood (Osiris)



Annual appearance of IBIS (Thoth) with the appearance of (Sopdet) Star in conjunction with sunrise at the peak of the annual flood (Osiris)



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A fourth great event coincided with the three events that the Egyptians considered the basis for the annual calendar (The Appearance of Sopdet star - Sunrise - Peak of the flood)

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> </ This event was the annual emergence of IBIS bird, with the peck of the flood, that considered as a sign of the beginning of the new year, and a symbol of the calendar and calculation in general, and they called it "Thoth", from which the name of the first month in the Egyptian year

named after it.

Every year, in the same time, (Thoth) back to carry out his sacres duty to search and excavate insects that harm agricultural land (Isis) with his beak that resembling a sickle and defend it against her enemies who threaten the opportunity for a new cultivation (birth), so, it was a symbol of healing and protecting Isis and her son Horus (the King).

Because of his love for calm and solitude, he was nicknamed the hermit bird and was a symbol of wisdom and knowledge.

By the end of the month (Thoth), Summer season ends & temperatures fall, so they said, "Thoth says to heat: die!".

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#### SEPTEMBER 5: ARRIVAL

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#### SEPTEMBER 11: SAILING INTO THE EGYPTIAN NEW YEAR

- Today marks the first day of the year on the Ancient Egyptian calendar.
- We will continue sailing north and stop at Gebel el Silsilla, known in Pharaonic times as Khenu (Place of Rowing), that was an important centre for the cult of the Nile. Every year at the beginning of the inundation season, sacrifices were made here to ensure the fertility of the land. The Nile at its height flowing through the narrow gorge must have been a particularly impressive sight, and noisy, which no doubt explains why the location was chosen as a cult centre.
- Then we visit Edfu Temple, a must-see on the journey between Aswan and Luxor. This imposing structure is one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt and the largest dedicated to Horus.
- And CHILL again sun bathing on the Dahabiya, you know the drill by now.

#### SEPTEMBER 12: ARRIVAL TO ESNA

- In the Medieval period, under Arab rule, Esna became a stop on the caravan routes that linked the Red Sea to the Western Desert oases. Today, it is renowned for the Esna locks on the Nile, where cruise boats patiently queue up to navigate this essential waterway.
- Visiting the marvelous Khnum temple where they discovered the Ancient Egyptian Zodiac, the hypostyle hall of the temple has been exceptionally preserved.
- Then we will take a stroll in the Qīsāriyya market, also known as the bazaar, which replaced the ceremonial path of old. Tourists must walk through it on foot between the ship and the temple.
